# Manager's Report – Steve Letavic Code/Zoning Officer

Mr. Letavic reported that Ed Kazlauskas has been hired as a part-time Code/Zoning Officer and will start April 29<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Letavic will continue the search for a full-time Codes/Zoning Officer.

## **PA American Water Grant Update**

Mr. Letavic reported that should monies be received from this grant it will be used to purchase approximately 950 trees and shrubs to plant in the lots along Swatara Creek Road that were purchased through the Hazard Mitigation by the township. All will be native to PA with wildlife and timber value and will also meet the criteria for Riparian Buffer. When we do the project it will be a multi-agency project with volunteers and staff working together and it will be easily maintained.

#### 10-Year Cash Flow

Mr. Letavic reported that he will be creating a financial plan for the municipality that projects future capital expenses for the board to consider when creating the budget each year. It will be a living document that will change, giving the board the ability to manage the cash flow.

### Public Works – Wade Burrell

Work Completed March, 2013

- Completed weekly road checks including checking signs, storm water inlets, general road conditions, and for possible debris on roadways causing a hazard to the community.
- Responded to Pennsylvania Call One requests for inspections of underground utilities.
- Responded to road permit requests, and issued necessary permits.
