RESOLUTION NO.: 2026 -10

A RESOLUTION OF THE LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 16, PART 1 THE LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP PARK AND CODE OF ORDINANCES, PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE OPERATION AND CONDUCT OF THE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES OPERATED BY THE TOWNSHIP.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Londonderry Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania hereby adopt the following rules and regulations for the operation and conduct of the recreational facilities of the Township:

1. TOWNSHIP PARKS SHALL BE OPEN FOR PUBLIC USE ON A YEAR ROUND BASIS, WITH SOME AREAS AND FACILITIES NOT BEING AVAILABLE DURING CERTAIN SEASONS.
2. NO PERSONS ARE PERMITTED IN ANY PARK DURING THE HOURS OF DARKNESS, EXCEPT IN THOSE AREAS DESIGNATED FOR EXTENDED USE ACTIVITIES, OR UNLESS WRITTEN PERMISSION IS OBTAINED FROM THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR AFTER DARK PROGRAMS.
3. BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MAY TEMPORARILY CLOSE OR CURTAIL ACTIVITIES UPON ANY LANDS OR WATERS OR ANY PORTION THEREOF, WHEN IT HAS BEEN DEEMED NECESSARY TO BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF PUBLIC SAFETY, CONDUCT, HEALTH OR ORDER.
4. SWIMMING IS PROHIBITED IN ALL PARKS EXCEPT ON FACILITIES EXPRESSLY DESIGNATED FOR THAT PURPOSE, PERSONAL BATHING PROHIBITED.
5. NO PERSONS SHALL RIDE IN OR DRIVE ANY MOTOR VEHICLE WHICH IS SELF-PROPELLED UPON ANY PARKLAND, EXCEPT UPON THE ROADS, OR ON AREAS WHICH ARE DESIGNATED AND PROVIDED FOR SUCH PURPOSES. IT IS PROHIBITED FOR ANY PERSONS TO COMMIT ANY ACT, BY USE OF OPERATION, OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE ON ANY PARK AND, WHICH IF COMMITTED UPON PUBLIC HIGHWAY OR STREET, IN THE STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA WOULD BE PROHIBITED AND UNLAWFUL. SPEED LIMITS WITHIN ALL PARKS SHALL BE 15 MILES PER HOUR UNLESS OTHERWISE POSTED. NO ONE SHALL TEST, REPAIR, OR WASH ANY VEHICLE OR MECHANICAL DEVICE IN ANY PARK. THERE SHALL BE NO PARKING AT ANY TIME EXCEPT IN AREAS DESIGNATED FOR SUCH PURPOSES.
6. NO PERSON SHALL WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, ERECT, PAINT, PASTE OR OTHERWISE AFFIX OR DISTRIBUTE ANY SIGNS, ADVERTISEMENTS, OR CIRCULARS ON PARK PROPERTY. THE SALE OF ANYTHING OR THE SOLICITATION OF FUNDS OR DONATIONS WITHIN ANY PARK

IS FORBIDDEN, EXCEPT UPON WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

7. THE SALE CONSUMPTION, OR POSSESSION OF DANGEROUS OR NARCOTIC DRUGS, OR GAMBLING OF ANY KIND IS PROHIBITED IN ANY PARK.
8. THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS OR BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED.
9. NO PERSON SHALL CUT, BREAK, MOVE, TAKE OR OTHERWISE INJURE, DESTROY OR DEFACE ANY TREES, SHRUBS, PLANTS, TURF, ROCK OR ANY BUILDING, FENCE, BRIDGE, SIGN OR OTHER STRUCTURE; OR FOUL ANY STREAM, OR DUMP ANY EARTH, RUBBISH, OR OTHER SUBSTANCE OR MATERIAL IN OR UPON ANY PARK.
10. NO PERSON SHALL MAKE OR KINDLE ANY OPEN FIRE EXCEPT IN FIREPLACES AND GRILLS PROVIDED FOR THIS PURPOSE OR IN PRIVATE PORTABLE GRILLS, APPROVED AS SAFE BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS. GRILLS PROVIDED FOR PUBLIC USE SHALL BE ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS, EXCEPT BY WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.
11. NO PERSONS SHALL, IN ANY PARK, SET A TRAP OR SNARE, OR SHOOT, INJURE, ANNOY, DISTURB, POISON ANY WILD ANIMAL OR BIRD, OR INJURE OR DESTROY ANY NEST. IF REQUIRED FOR CONTROL SPECIAL PERMISSION MAY BE GRANTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.
12. ALL PERSONS ARE FORBIDDEN TO USE THREATENING ABUSIVE, INSULTING OR INDECENT LANGUAGE, OR COMMIT ANY OBSCENE OR INDECENT ACT OR TO FIGHT IN ANY PARK.
13. HORSES, CATTLE, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR ANY KIND ARE PROHIBITED IN ANY PARK, EXCEPT A DOG OR CAT ON A LEASH UNDER CONTROL OF A PERSON IS PERMITTED. HORSEBACK RIDING IS PROHIBITED, EXCEPT ON FACILITIES EXPRESSLY DESIGNATED FOR THAT PURPOSE.
14. NO PERSON SHALL CARRY A KNIFE UPON THEIR PERSON HAVING A BLADE OF THREE (3) INCHES OR LONGER IN LENGTH, OR HAVE POSSESSION OF, OR DISCHARGE A BB GUN, AIR RIFLE, PISTOL, FIREARM, BOW AND ARROW, OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF LETHAL WEAPON IN ANY PARK, EXCEPT ON FACILITIES EXPRESSLY DESIGNATED FOR THAT PURPOSE.
15. PRACTICING, PLAYING, OR USING PARK AREAS FOR GOLF AND ARCHERY IS PROHIBITED, EXCEPT ON FACILITIES EXPRESSLY DESIGNATED OR PROVIDED FOR SUCH PURPOSES.
16. NO ENTERTAINMENT, DEMONSTRATION, OR EXHIBITION SHALL BE GIVEN IN ANY PARK EXCEPT BY APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS. NO DJ'S, LIVE MUSIC, PERFORMANCES, OR AMPLIFIED MUSIC ARE PERMITTED.
17. PERMITS FOR PLAYING LEAGUE OR CASUAL ATHLETIC GAMES ON PARK FIELDS OR COURTS MAY BE SECURED ON FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS FROM THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS. ALL PERMITS THAT ARE GRANTED MUST BE PRODUCED UPON DEMAND, IN ORDER TO AVOID CONFLICTS IN THE USE OF FACILITIES.
18. RESERVATION PERMITS FOR GROUP PICNIC FACILITIES MAY BE OBTAINED FOR A FEE FROM THE TOWNSHIP.

19. NO PERSON OR PERSONS SHALL WILLINGLY ENCROACH UPON LANDS OWNED BY THE TOWNSHIP.
20. NO FISHING SHALL BE PERMITTED IN ALL WATERS.
21. TRASH MUST BE PLACED IN TRASH BAGS, TIED SECURELY, AND PLACED IN THE PROVIDED TRASH RECEPTACLES.
22. ALCOHOL IS PERMITTED, HOWEVER, GLASS CONTAINERS ARE NOT PERMITTED. INTOXICATION IS PROHIBITED.
23. OVERNIGHT CAMPING IS PROHIBITED.
24. BUILDING FIRES IN AREAS OTHER THAN PICNIC GRILLS IS PROHIBITED.
25. PETS MUST BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES. PET WASTE MUST BE CLEANED UP BY THE PET OWNER.
26. PETS ARE PROHIBITED ON ALL BALL FIELDS, BALL COURTS, AND OTHER SPORTS AREAS.
27. RENTAL EQUIPMENT SUCH AS A BOUNCE HOUSE, DUNK TANK, OR SIMILAR ARE PROHIBITED.
28. CATERERS OR FOOD TRUCKS MAY BE PERMITTED UPON REVIEW OF THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER AND ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE NAMING LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP AS AN ADDITIONAL INSURED.
29. NAILS, STAPLES, OR TACKS CANNOT BE USED ON THE PICNIC TABLES OR PAVILION POSTS. IF NAILS, STAPLES, OR TACKS ARE FOUND ANYWHERE FOLLOWING THE USE OF A PAVILION OR FIELD, THE USER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST OF REMOVAL AND REPAIR.
30. THE USE OF THE FIELDS OR PARK SPACE FOR ORGANIZED SPORTS OR ACTIVITIES MUST BE SCHEDULED THROUGH THE TOWNSHIP OFFICE
31. WATER PUMPS LOCATED IN THE PARK ARE LOCKED AND NOT ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC.
32. TOWNSHIP VOLUNTEERS, EMPLOYEES, AND NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR REDUCED PAVILION RENTAL COSTS AT AN AMOUNT AS DETERMINED FROM TIME TO TIME BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.
33. ALL OF THE AFOREMENTIONED RULES REQUIRING WRITTEN PERMISSION, REQUIRE THAT SUCH PERMITS MUST BE CARRIED AND PRODUCED UPON DEMAND.
