

RESOLUTION 2026-17
Authorization to Close LVFC Capital Construction
Mid Penn Bank Checking Account

A RESOLUTION OF LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, authorizing the closing of a Mid Penn Bank Account and the Distribution of the remaining balance to Londonderry Fire Company No. 1 for volunteer firefighter incentives.

WHEREAS, Londonderry Township (the "Township") currently maintains a bank account at Mid Penn Bank titled LVFC Capital Construction, Account Number ending in 580, which has remained dormant and has solely earned interest over the past five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, said account was previously utilized in connection with the fundraising campaign conducted by TMI for the benefit of Londonderry Fire Company No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that the LVFC Capital Construction account is no longer necessary for its original intended purpose; and

WHEREAS, as of the date of this Resolution, the remaining balance in said account is \$46,753.49; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to close the LVFC Capital Construction account and distribute the remaining funds to Londonderry Fire Company No. 1 for the purpose of funding volunteer firefighter incentives; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that providing such funds for volunteer firefighter incentives serves a valid public purpose and promotes the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Londonderry Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Londonderry Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. The Mid Penn Bank account titled LVFC Capital Construction, Account Number ending in 580, shall be closed effective April 7, 2026 (the day following the duly scheduled Board of Supervisors meeting at which this Resolution is considered).
2. The remaining balance in the amount of \$46,753.49, plus or minus any accrued interest or bank adjustments through the date of closing, shall be disbursed to Londonderry Fire Company No. 1 for the purpose of funding volunteer firefighter incentives.
3. The Township's Township Manager, David Blechertas, and Township's Finance Director, Brian R Marchuck, are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to effectuate the closing of the account and the transfer of funds as set forth herein.

THIS RESOLUTION has been duly acted upon and is hereby adopted by the Supervisors of Londonderry Township this 6th day of April 2026.
