

RESOLUTION 2026-19

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LONDONDERRY, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF PERSONAL PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Township of Londonderry, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania (the “Township”), is a Second-Class Township and a Municipality existing under laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Second-Class Township Code, pursuant to Section 66504, permits the disposition of personal property without public notice if such property has been determined to have an aggregate value of less than \$2,000; and

WHEREAS, the Township has 9, 8ft long wooden picnic tables, and believe the disposition of the Property is in the best interest of the Township and therefore, authorize the disposal of the same through the means determined appropriate by the Manager to dispose of said property efficiently and in accordance with federal and state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Londonderry, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, that the Manager is authorized to dispose of the Property in a manner that ensures the security of the Township’s information, is cost effective, and is in accordance with all applicable environmental laws.
