

OVERVIEW:

 The combination of gusty winds, dry fuels, and low relative humidity will result in a critical (high) risk of rapid wildfire spread on Friday.

TIMING

 The lowest relative humidity values and strongest wind gusts will occur on Friday afternoon.

HAZARDS &

IMPACTS

RH values near or below 30% and westerly winds sustained 5-15mph with gusts 20-30mph will lead to a critical risk of wildfire spread.
 Any fires that start may get out of control quickly.

NWS ALERTS

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

A Red Flag Warning is in effect for most of southeast PA.
A Fire Weather Watch has been issued for portions of south central PA

along, south, and east of the I-99/I-80 corridor.

There will be an elevated risk of wildfire spread across most of

Pennsylvania tomorrow, even outside of Watch/Warning areas.

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

Dry conditions continue on Saturday, but winds will be lighter.

Light to moderate rain Sunday: 0.5-0.75" west; 0.25-0.5" east.
