



# Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in the U.S.

#### As of July 13, 2020

In the United States, there have been 3,296,599 confirmed cases of COVID-19 detected through U.S. public health surveillance systems in 50 states and the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, the Northern Marianas Islands, and U.S. Virgin Islands.
