Londonderry Township Board of Supervisors held a Public Hearing on Monday, February 4, 2008 at the Municipal Building, 783 S. Geyers Church Road, Middletown, PA 17057 beginning at 6:30 pm.

Public Hearing: Conditional Use Hearing to consider the Conditional Use Application of the Dauphin County Commissioners with regards to an application to construct a telecommunications tower facility on the Amergen Energy Co., LLC property, known as Three Mile Island Training Center.

Charlie Hebel, Technical Specialist for SSI Services, Inc was sworn in and presented testimony on the entire Conditional Use Application and all submissions.

Township Engineer Darrell Becker – this plan has received approval from the Zoning Hearing Board and has met all zoning requirements.

4. **Manager's Report** – Steve Letavic

Resolution 2008-3 Upgrade of Street Lights by Met-Ed: This allows Met-Ed to upgrade four (4), 100 watt, mercury vapor, conventional streetlights to 70 watt, high-pressure sodium vapor, cobrahead, luminaries along Hertzler Road. There is no charge to the Township for this upgrade.

Vice Chair LeHew made a motion to approve Resolution 2008-3 Upgrade of Street Lights by Met-Ed Supervisor Dale seconded motion, motion carried.

Resolution 2008-2 Township Manager 2008 Compensation: This sets the 2008 compensation of the township manager in the amount of \$74,160.

Vice Chair LeHew made a motion to approve Resolution 2008-2 Township Manager 2008 Compensation, Supervisor Dale seconded motion, motion carried.

Waiver of Building Permit Fees for the Londonderry Fire Company No 1 construction project: Mr. Letavic asked the BOS to waive the building permit fees for the fire company's construction project. He pointed out that the contractor would merely add the fees to the cost of the project.

Supervisor Kopp made a motion to waive the building permit fees for the Londonderry Fire Company No 1 construction project, Supervisor Dale seconded motion, motion carried.

TND Consultant:

Upon completion of an RFP and interviewing several candidates Chairman Doherty recommended URDC as the consultant of choice to complete the TND ordinance. The cost of their proposal is \$6,900.

Chairman Doherty made a motion to approve URDC as the TND consultant at the proposed rate not to exceed \$6,900, Vice Chair LeHew seconded motion, motion carried.

5. <u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Chris Feese

Ms. Feese asked for the approval of payment of invoices from the General Fund, Golf Course, Escrow and Liquid Fuels in the following amounts:

b) Grant waiver of preliminary plan.

c) Grant approval of plan subject to two (2) conditions: 1) execution of the easement agreement, 2) execution of the use agreement between Dauphin County and the property owner Amergen Energy Co., LLC.

Supervisor Kopp made a motion to grant approval of the Dauphin County EMA Plan subject to two (2) conditions: 1) execution of the easement agreement, 2) execution of the use agreement between Dauphin County and the property owner Amergen Energy Co., LLC., Vice Chair LeHew seconded motion, motion carried.

Mr. Foreman provided the BOS with a status report on the mobile home park's code compliance issues.
