1. **Salute the Flag**

Citizen's Input

2. **Managers Report – Mr. Letavic**

School Heights Village Project: The board voted on the conditional use application with proposed conditions. Prior to the vote much discussion centered around the impact the development may have on the township's existing 537 plan and proposed update to the plan.
