TOWNSHIP OF LONDONDERRY, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania

RESOLUTION NO.	2020-8
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WHEREAS, the Township of Londonderry, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania (the "Township"), has determined to enter into an Intermunicipal Agreement, to be dated as provided therein (the "Agreement"), with the Derry Township Municipal Authority (the "Authority"), in connection with the construction of certain sanitary sewage collection facilities in the Township, the lease of said facilities to the Authority and other related matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Londonderry, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. This Township shall enter into the Agreement with the Authority whereby, the Township will covenant and agree to acquire, construct and own certain sanitary sewage collection facilities required for rendering sanitary sewage services in and for a portion of the Township known as "Londonderry Estates" (the "Facilities"), and whereby the Township will lease the Facilities to the Authority for operation and maintenance of the Facilities and treatment of the sanitary sewage collected by the Facilities, and other related matters. The Agreement shall be substantially in the form presented to this meeting, which Agreement and the form thereof are approved..

SECTION 2. This Township shall enter into the Agreement, substantially in the form presented to this meeting, which form is approved; and a copy of the Agreement in the form so presented and approved shall be filed with this Township's Secretary and made available for inspection at reasonable times by interested persons requesting such inspection, together with such changes and modifications thereof as are approved by the officers of this Township executing and delivering the same, which approval conclusively shall be deemed to have been given upon execution and delivery thereof.

SECTION 3. The Chairman or Vice Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and the Secretary or Assistant Secretary of this Township, as applicable, are authorized and directed to execute, to attest and to deliver the Agreement, substantially in the form referred to in Section 2.

SECTION 4. Proper officers of this Township are authorized and directed to execute all documents and to do all other acts that may be necessary and proper to carry out this Resolution and the undertakings of this Township in the Agreement, including, but not limited to, any submissions to or filings with the Department in connection with this Township's Official Sewage Facilities Plan and the Agreement.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.

SECTION 6. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution, it being the intent of this Township that such remainder of this Resolution shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. All Resolutions and parts of Resolutions inconsistent herewith expressly are repealed.
